TREE-DAY LABORATORY TRAINING of new and old procedures in cosmetic gynecology, enhanced by live surgery videos, dry & wet laboratories using fresh animal commercial flesh. Didactic lectures supported by selected PowerPoint slides demonstrating actual surgery. This educational event is designed for entry-level surgeons who need primary teaching and for advanced entry-level surgeons. Such combinations, basic and advanced, will assist entry-level surgeons in integrating Cosmetic-Plastic Gynecology into clinical practices, advanced entry-level surgeons will significantly reduce the potential for severe surgical complications, and educators will have guidelines and educational material for teaching cosmetic-plastic gynecology (CPG).

WORKSHOP OVERVIEW: This course/workshop will fulfill expectations for surgeons looking for a modern, state-of-the-art practical approach to teaching how to weave into practice new CPG services. Today, in response to ever-growing demands by women for cosmetic-plastic gynecologic operations around the globe, many surgeons are trying to enter this field without adequate preparation *FOR SURGICAL CHALLENGES*. This situation leads to severe but avoidable surgical complications that produce "female sexual invalids" when not adequately prepared surgeons for the independent practice of cosmetic-plastic gynecology try to do CPG surgery. A residency in Ob/Gyn or other programs does not offer teaching and training of future CPG surgeons for independent practice.

Prof. Ostrzenski has designed and developed a new course/workshop based on anatomical discoveries and traditional anatomy teaching for starting surgeons and actively CPG practicing surgeons. Combining two words, basic and advanced, Prof. Ostrzenski signals that both groups, beginners and currently practicing surgeons taking this course/workshop, will benefit since many severe complications of CPG are related to general cosmetic-plastic principles and anatomy.

This course/workshop would **NOT** include traditional gynecologic operations in which the procedure terms were changed and used as female genital cosmetic surgery. All course/workshop sessions will be conducted by Prof. Ostrzenski in English and by a special request in Polish language.
