*Prof. Dr. Alan Sacerdote received a full University Professor from George's University School of Medicine and was appointed to Clinical Professor of Medicine SUNY Downstate. Additionally, he served as a Director of the Division of Endocrinology at SUNY Downstate.*

*Prof. Sacerdote held a specialty in Medicine and Endocrinology, did extensive clinical-scientific research, and published his findings in gynecology on polycystic ovarian syndrome (PCOS) & Congenital Adrenal Hyperplasia.*

*From 1977 until his retirement, Prof. Sacerdote has been active in clinical practice as a teacher, journal editor, and clinical-scientific investigator. He is a well-published author in medicine who developed with his coworker's groundbreaking treatments for diabetic enteropathy, sickle-cell disease, classic and non-classic adrenal hyperplasia, a polycystic ovarian syndrome associated with neurocysticercosis, primary hyperaldosteronism, Cushing's Disease, and ornithine transcarboxylase deficiency.*
