Title

Labiolysis: Corrective surgery for labia minora iatrogenic fusion

Objectives

To describe step-by-step labiolytic surgical technique and to ascertain surgical outcomes.

Method

Under local anesthesia, the right labium minus was sharply dissected from the iatrogenic fusion between the intralabial crease and the labium major. The three traction sutures were applied to the labium minus and put on tension, by securing with medical-type, traction sutures on the outer surface of the sport protective cup for boys. The cup was filled with crushed ice and removed at any time for the patient's urination and cleaning of the wound. The wound healing was by secondary intention method, and the surgery was executed in two stages for each site separately, three months apart. Validated instruments were used before and after surgeries to evaluate the outcomes.

Results

No reoperation was performed, and no major or minor complications were observed. Iatrogenic anatomical deformities were corrected with a very pleasing esthetic anatomical outcome and total functional restoration. The postoperative course was uneventful.

Conclusion

Labiolytic is a simple surgical operation with a short learning curve, which relieves symptoms, improves the quality of life, and provides an esthetically pleasing surgical outcome.
